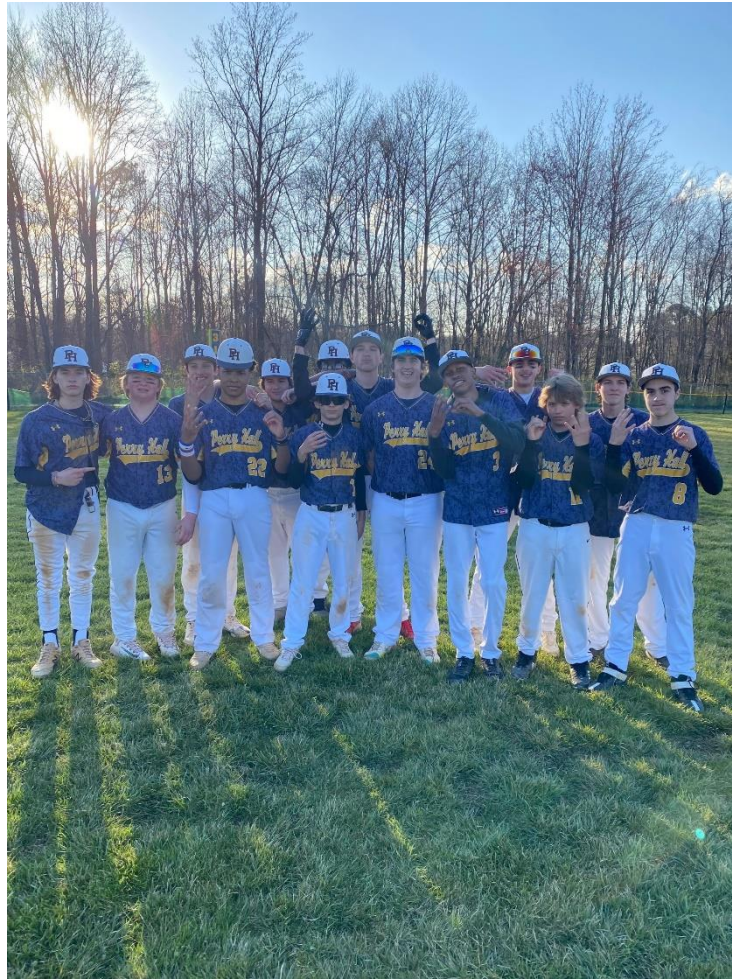

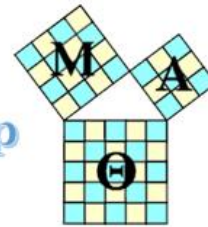

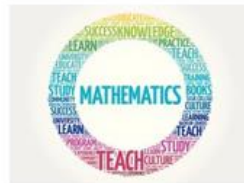

Perry Hall Mock Trial had a great season and qualified for the Final Four in their circuit! The team can't wait to return to the courtroom next year for an even better run!



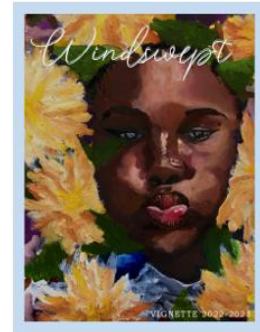

- **Maryland Boys State Summer Program for Juniors**

Are you a male Junior interested in government, law, or politics? The 2023 Maryland American Legion Boys State program will be held on Sunday, June 18, 2023 through Saturday, June 24, 2023 at McDaniel College in Westminster, Maryland. **Tuition for the program is fully funded by The American Legion.** Attendees need to report on campus at the Gill Gym at noon on Sunday, June 18th. The graduation exercise is Saturday June 24th at 9:00 AM and parents and family members are encouraged to attend.

Website [//www.mdlegion.org/boysstate](http://www.mdlegion.org/boysstate) contains an overview of the Boys State program, the 2023 application portal, scholarship opportunities offered by McDaniel College and Samsung. Applications must be completed by May 1st.

- **Maryland Girls State Summer Program for Juniors**

Are you a female Junior interested in government, law or politics? ALA Maryland Girls State is a summer weeklong learning experience, often held at Salisbury University where rising seniors live in “cities” within a dormitory-like setting. Our program uses a nonpartisan curriculum where students assume the roles of government leaders, campaigning in mock parties (often called “Federalists” and “Nationalists”) to become mayors and county and state officials of their ALA Girls State. They offer both college and career readiness in our program. The program costs \$290 which includes housing, meals, a shirt, and a phone wallet **which is paid for** by an American Legion Auxiliary Unit. There is a \$45 registration fee that the attendee is responsible to pay, but this fee potentially can be covered by request to the sponsoring American Legion Auxiliary Unit. We encourage all interested young ladies in their junior year of high school to apply and we will work with them to find a sponsoring unit. Participants who are direct descendants of US Wartime Veterans or Active-Duty Service members are eligible to apply for the Samsung Scholarship which covers up to \$10,000 of the winner’s college tuition. There are a few other scholarships offered as well.
